


Funding Opportunities for the Second Year in Paris (MAPPA Program)

In addition to the Erasmus+ grant and potential support from the University of Padua via the Vinci 2021 Project (Université Franco-Italienne), several other funding options are available for MAPPA students during their second year in Paris.

1. PSL University Scholarships

Each spring (next: **Spring 2026**), the 10 MAPPA students will be ranked by a committee at **PSL University**. The top **N** students will receive:

- **€500/month** for **10 months**

 Note: The number of available scholarships (**N**) varies each year based on funding. Over the past four years, the average number of recipients has been **5**.

2. Eiffel Excellence Scholarships

MAPPA students are encouraged to apply for the **Eiffel Scholarships**, funded by the French Ministry for Europe and Foreign Affairs. Applications are typically due in **Fall 2025**.

- **€1,181/month** for up to **12 months**
- Highly competitive and prestigious

3. French Government Scholarships

Students may also apply in **Spring 2026** for scholarships offered by the **French government**, via the Institut Français.

Important Information

- Scholarships (1), (2), and (3) are **not cumulative**.
- MAPPA's **French coordinators** will assist students in preparing applications.

Additional Support

Students **not selected** for either the **PSL** or **Eiffel** scholarships may receive **additional support** of approximately €**2000** during their Master's thesis (**Spring 2026**), provided they choose a thesis supervisor affiliated with a **PSL laboratory** (**Dauphine** or **École Normale Supérieure**).



This support **can be combined** with scholarship (3).
